

Bridgwater Launches Driver CPC Training

Our Bridgwater Centre will be delivering training to Large Goods Vehicle (LGV) and Passenger Carrying Vehicle (PCV) drivers from businesses in the South West, enabling them to meet the new EU requirement for Certificate of Professional Competence (CPC) periodic training. The law requires these drivers to undertake 35 hours of training in every 5 year period for as long as they drive professionally.

Dave Dowson joined Bridgwater as a Trainer\Assessor on 20th April and is currently working hard to launch the programme. Dave started with First Bus as a driver in 1995, by 2005 he had become an NVQ Assessor and Internal Verifier, studying at Bridgwater to achieve the CIPD Certificate in Training Practice. Dave comes to us from National Express where he has been delivering CPC periodic training to coach drivers since the EU Regulation took effect on 10th September 2008.
