

AIR CONDITIONING QUALIFICATIONS

As you will be aware, European Union F Gas Regulations require that technicians involved in the servicing and removal of Mobile Air Conditioning (MAC) systems in cars and light vans have completed relevant training and certification.

Since July 2008, it has been a requirement that all new MAC technicians achieve an approved Refrigerant Gas Handling qualification within 12 months of commencing their role. By 4th July 2010, all MAC technicians must achieve an approved qualification, including those who have already completed “in house” training.

We offer qualifications which meet the requirements of EU F Gas Regulation EC842-2006 and annex EC307-2008 for technicians involved in the servicing and removal of Mobile Air Conditioning (MAC) systems in cars and light vans.
